Q: What are some differences between ceramic tile and porcelain tile? A: Porcelain tile has a water absorption of less than .5%. While both porcelain and ceramic tiles are fired, porcelain is fired at higher temperatures for a longer time than ceramic. Porcelain also has a higher feldspar content which makes it more durable. Ceramic tiles are typically less expensive.
